AI 7 Improvements to satellite procedures

Goal: To provide regulatory certainty & flexibility

- **Genesis:** Resolution 86 (Rev. Marrakesh, 2002)
- **Issue:** to consider possible changes, and other options, in response to Resolution 86 (Rev. Marrakesh, 2002) of the Plenipotentiary Conference, an advance publication, coordination, notification and recording procedures for frequency assignments pertaining to satellite networks, in order to facilitate rational, efficient and economical use of radio frequencies and any associated orbits, including the geostationary satellite orbit.

Status: There are 13 sub-issues in the draft CPM text under Agenda item 7, issues A – M, where Issue C contains 7 sub-issues in itself, C1-C7, making it 19 issues in Agenda item 7

GSC General Position

- Favours a stable and predictable regulatory framework for efficient and economical use of spectrum and orbit resources. Hence, GSC supports retaining the current process of continuing evolution at successive WRCs of the regime governing space service, increasing flexibility to access spectrum while protecting existing systems.
- Favours the review of any RR provision which can bring accurate solutions to specific detected inconsistencies and develop new improved provisions with emphasis on solving the most urgent issues, i.e. well characterized issues whose improvement is urgent and impacting.
